BIG ON THE INSIDE

1) God is making us BIGER on the inside

- And God gave Solomon wisdom and exceedingly great understanding, and largeness of heart like the sand on the seashore. I Kings 4:29
- Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. For I rejoiced greatly when brethren came and testified of the truth that is in you, just as you walk in the truth. III John 1:2-3

2) God has given us a BIG faith

- And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and signs among the people. Acts 6:8
- For he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were added to the Lord. Acts 11:24
- He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God. Romans 4:20
- But Jesus looked at them and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." Matthew 19:26

3) A BIG God lives inside us

- You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world. I John 4:4
- This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit," says the Lord of hosts. Zechariah 4:6
- I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency]. Philippians 4:13 AMP

4) A BIG person sees the BIG inside of others

- God recognized the potential of David, a shepherd boy who possessed a heart after God.
- God saw that potential in Gideon while hiding in the winepress.
- Jesus saw the potential in Matthew the Tax Collector.
- Jesus saw the potential within the hard-working fishermen.
- Jesus saw the potential in Saul a persecutor of the church.
- Jesus saw the potential in you!
- But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart." I Samuel 16:7
- So, from now on, we refuse to evaluate people merely by their outward appearances. For that's how we once viewed the Anointed One, but no longer do we see him with limited human insight. 'Now, if anyone is enfolded into Christ, he has become an entirely new person. All that is related to the old order has vanished. Behold, everything is fresh and new. 2 Corinthians 5:16-17 TPT
