# A LAME MAN HEALED

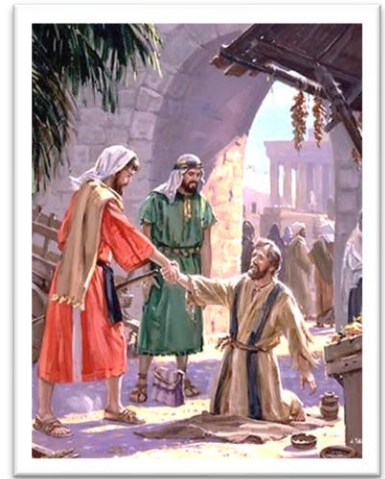
## ACTS 3 & 4

### 1) What are your expectations? – Acts 3:1-5

- *I would have lost heart, unless I had believed That I would see the goodness of the Lord In the land of the living. Wait on the Lord; Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the Lord! Psalms 27:13-14*
- *Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us. Ephesians 3:20*

### 2) The Name of Jesus – Acts 3:6-16, Luke 10:17-20, Mark 16:15-18

- *Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, 'that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth. Philippians 2:9-10*
- *And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full. John 16:23-24*



### 3) Peter and John arrested – Acts 4:1-22

- *So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, And His glory from the rising of the sun; When the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him. Isaiah 59:19*
- *God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble. Psalms 46:1*

### 4) The response to opposition to the gospel is prayer – Acts 4:23-31

- *But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. 'Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were loosed. Acts 16:25-26*

God wants to give you a fresh filling of boldness. Boldness is not arrogance but confidence in your faith – 2 Timothy 1:6-7

*[35] Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. [36] For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise. Hebrews 10:35-36 NKJV*
